

ORDINANCE NO. 05-O-10

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 6-52 AND 6-53 OF THE CODE OF GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR BOARD MEMBERSHIP AND TERMS OF THE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the people of the City of Tallahassee, Florida, as follows:

Section 1. Section 6-52 is hereby amended in the Code of General Ordinances of the City of Tallahassee, Florida, and shall read as follows:

Sec. 6-52. Designation of agency; appointment of ~~county commissioners~~ ex-officio members; appointment of agency chairman and vice-chairman.

(a) The community redevelopment agency shall be governed by a board of commissioners consisting of ~~seven persons, which shall be composed as follows:~~ the five members of the city commission, ~~and two members appointed by the city commission from a slate of three nominations for each position submitted by the board of county commissioners of the county.~~

(b) The ~~nominations by the~~ board of county commissioners of the county shall ~~be made~~ appoint two ex-officio, non-voting members pursuant to a procedure chosen and implemented by the board of county commissioners of the county.

1 (c) The city commission authorizes the agency to annually
2 designate the chairman and vice-chairman of the agency.

3 Section 2. Section 6-53 is hereby amended in the Code of General
4 Ordinances of the City of Tallahassee, Florida, and shall read as follows:

5 Sec. 6-53. Terms of office.

6 ~~These~~ agency commissioners ~~who are also members of the city~~
7 ~~commission~~ shall have terms which run concurrent with their city
8 commission terms. The two ~~additional agency commissioners~~ ex-officio,
9 non-voting members appointed by the board of county commissioners of
10 the county shall each have terms of ~~four~~ two years.

12 Section 3. Conflict With Other Ordinances and Codes. All
13 ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Code of Ordinances of the City of
14 Tallahassee, Florida, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby
15 repealed to the extent of such conflict.

16 Section 4. Severability. If any provision or portion of this
17 ordinance is declared by any court of competent jurisdiction to be void,
18 unconstitutional, or unenforceable, then all remaining provisions and portions
19 of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.


20 Section 5. Effective date. This ordinance shall become effective
21 immediately upon adoption.




